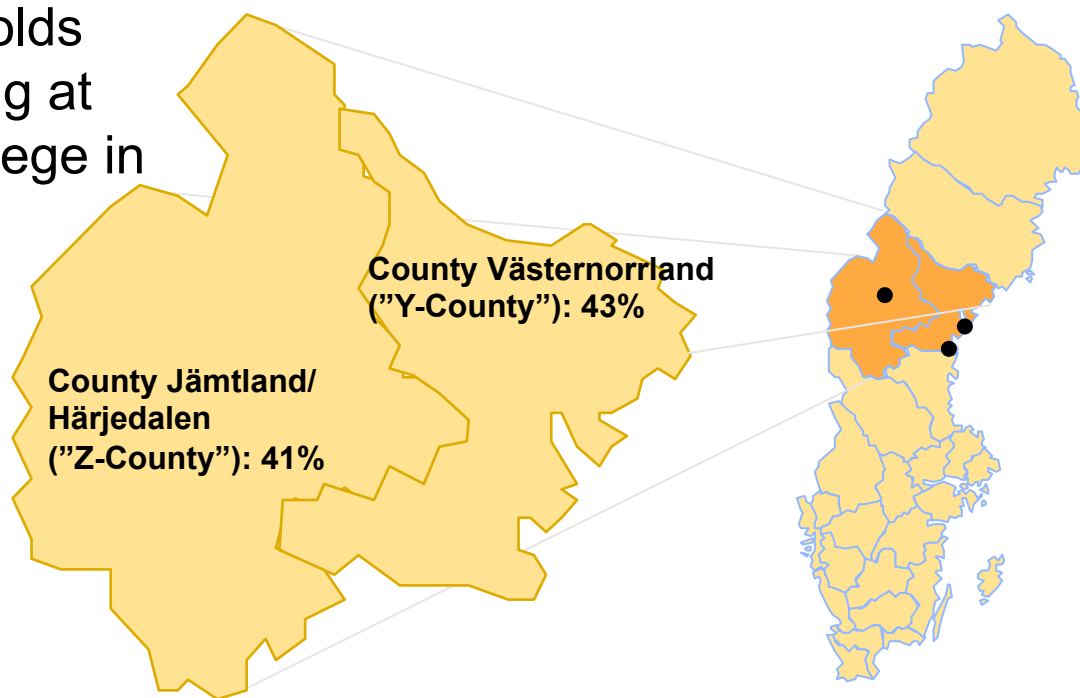

Percentage of 24-year-olds who had started studying at university/university college in 2008

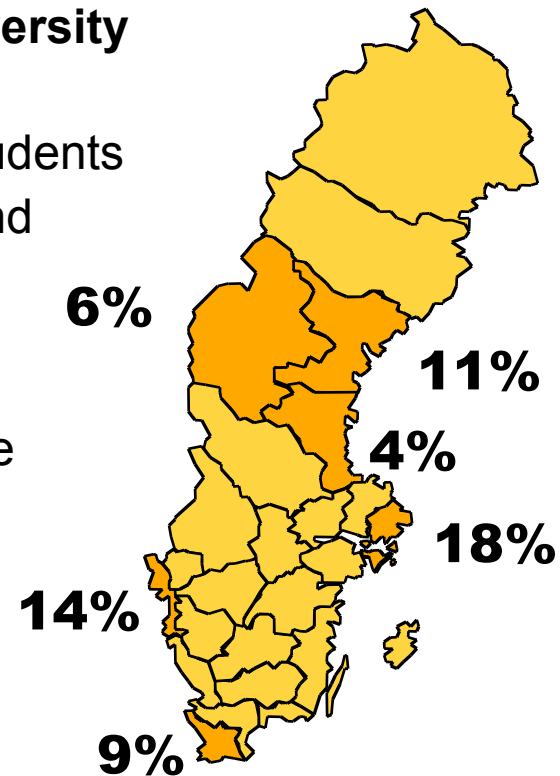
All Swedish municipalities: 43,6 %



Where do our students come from?

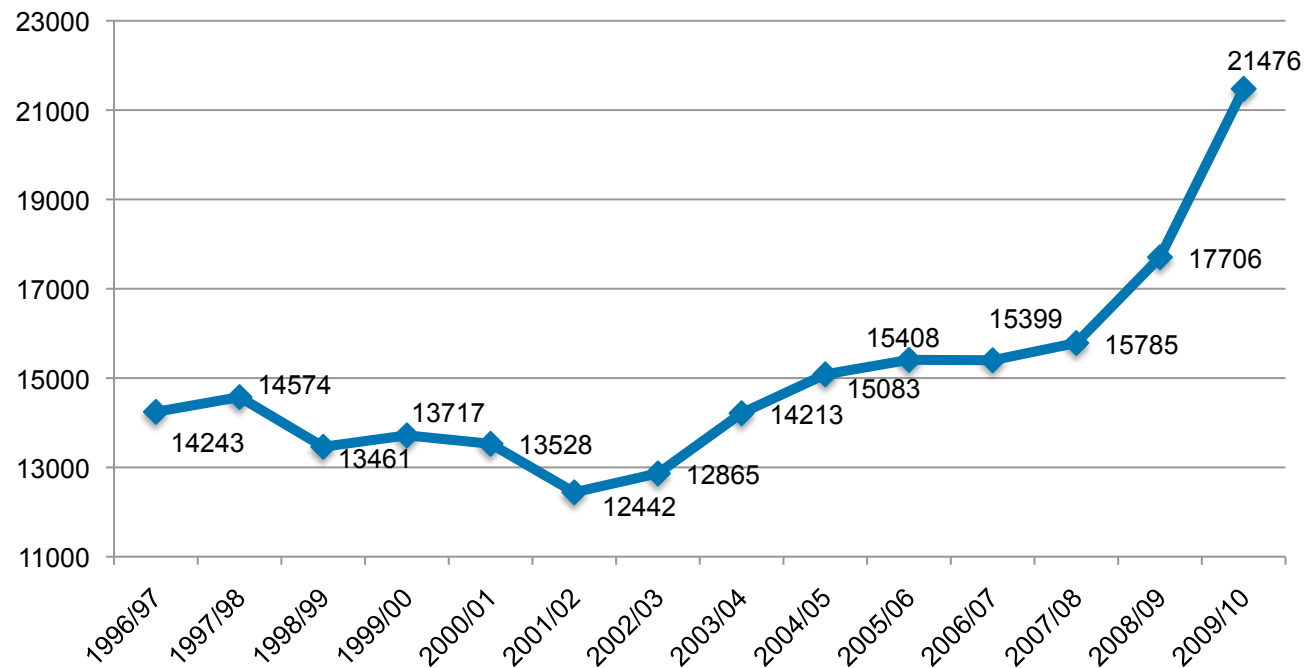
First-time students at Mid Sweden University

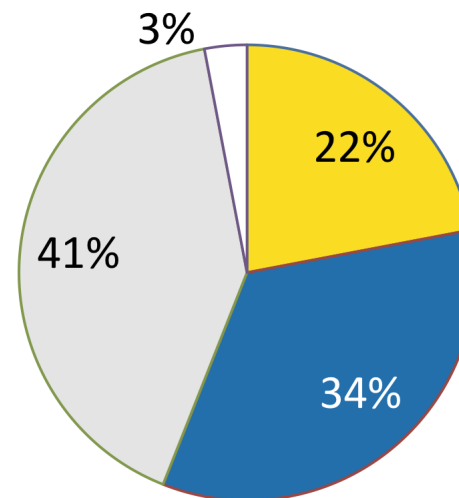
Total number of registered students (individuals) at Mid Sweden University during the academic year

- Other locations 3%



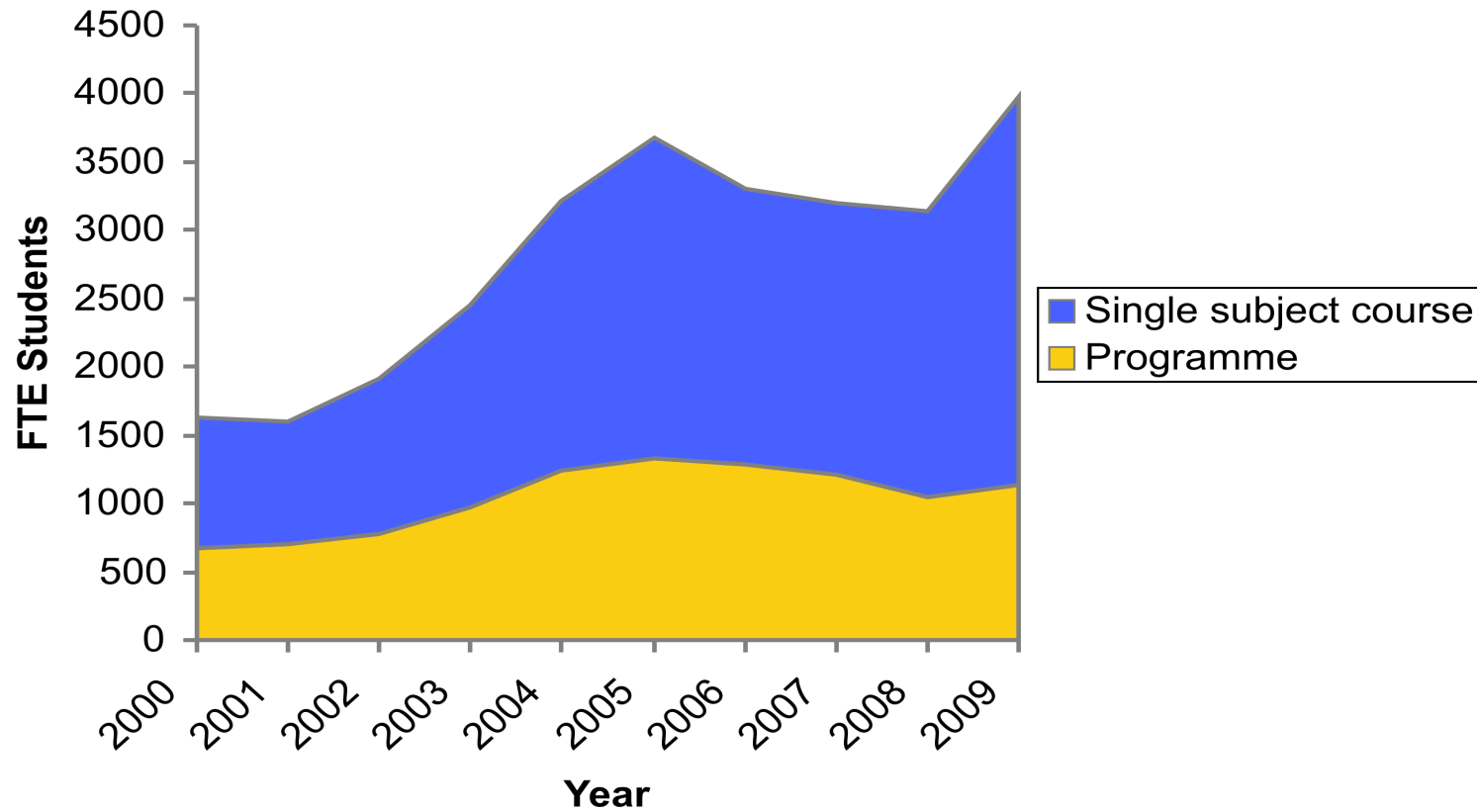

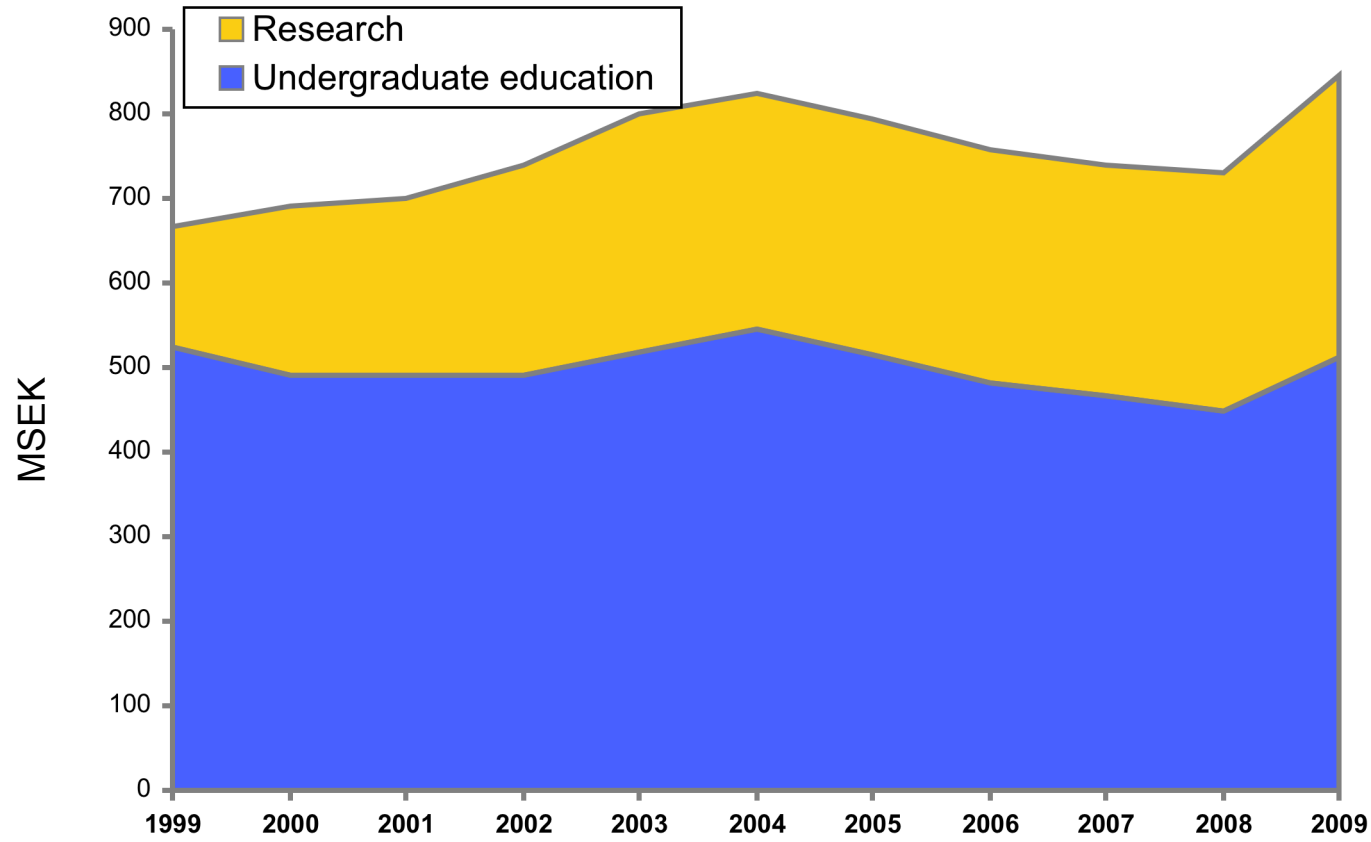

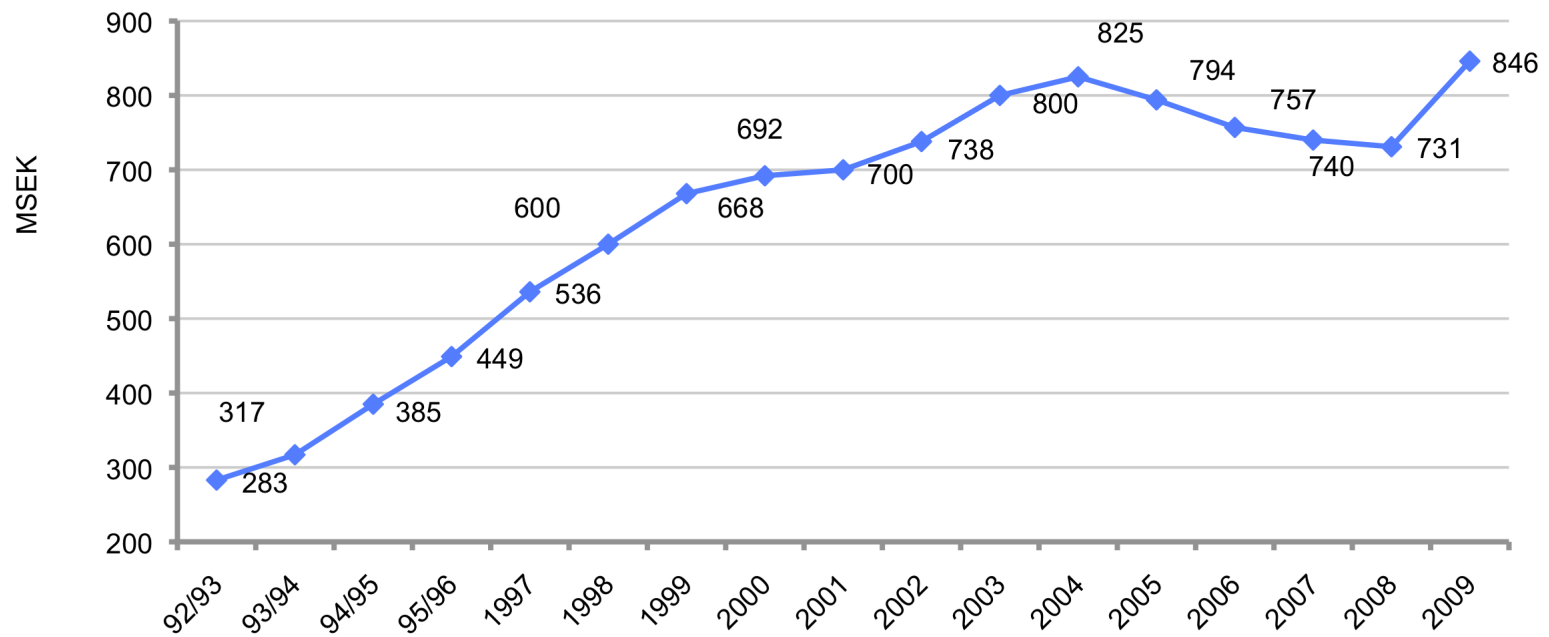
