

Subject specific grading criteria proposed by the Computer Engineering/Computer Science staff and established by the Board of Undergraduate Studies of Science, Technology and Media 2007-06-14.
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Grading Criteria: Computer Engineering

Computer Engineering and Computer Science are broad disciplines where a general progression cannot be proven. There are however several parallel parts within the subject in which there is an obvious progression. For this reason it is important to specify the grading criteria for each part of the subject area and also in each separate course syllabus.

This compilation should be considered a temporary solution until more specific grading criteria have been formulated for each course syllabus. To obtain the grade E or above all of the intended learning outcomes should be examined and each part should at least fulfill the requirements for the grade E. High marks are distributed according to the following.

Grade	Criteria
A	Level: Depending on the character of the specific course the following applies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The student demonstrates outstanding ability of judgment and outstanding approach considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.• The student demonstrates outstanding skills and abilities considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.• The student demonstrates outstanding knowledge and outstanding understanding considering the requirements of the course learning objectives. Range: Fulfills the course learning objectives very well.
B	Level: Depending on the character of the specific course the following applies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The student demonstrates excellent ability of judgment and a very good approach considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.• The student demonstrates excellent skills and ability considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.• The student demonstrates excellent knowledge and excellent understanding considering the requirements of the course learning objectives. Range: Fulfills all of the course learning objectives, most of which very well.
C	Level: Depending on the character of the specific course the following applies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The student demonstrates good ability of judgment and good approach considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.• The student demonstrates good skills and abilities considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.• The student demonstrates good knowledge and good understanding considering the requirements of the course learning objectives. Range: Fulfills all of the course learning objectives, several of which very well.
D	Level: Depending on the character of the specific course the following applies

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student demonstrates satisfactory ability of judgment and satisfactory approach considering the requirements of the course learning objectives. • The student demonstrates satisfactory skills and abilities considering the requirements of the course learning objectives. • The student demonstrates satisfactory knowledge and understanding considering the requirements of the course learning objectives. <p>Range: Fulfills all of the course learning objectives, of which a few very well.</p>
E	<p>Level: Depending on the character of the specific course the following applies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student demonstrates sufficient ability of judgment and approach according to the definitions of the course learning objectives. • The student demonstrates sufficient ability and skills in accordance with the definitions of the course learning objectives. • The student demonstrates sufficient knowledge and understanding in accordance with the definitions of the course learning objectives. <p>Range: Fulfills all of the course learning objectives.</p>
Fx	<p>Level: Depending on the character of the specific course the following applies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student demonstrates insufficient ability of judgment and/or insufficient approach in accordance with the definitions of the course learning objectives. • The student demonstrates insufficient skills and/or insufficient ability in accordance with the definitions of the course learning objectives. • The student demonstrates insufficient knowledge and or insufficient understanding in accordance with the definitions of the course learning objectives. <p>Range: Fulfills several of the course learning objectives, however not all of them. Additional work is required to fulfill all of the course learning objectives.</p> <p>Revision possible within the timeframe indicated by the examiner.</p>
F	<p>Level: Depending on the character of the specific course the following applies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student demonstrates insufficient ability of judgment and/or insufficient approach in accordance to the definitions of the course learning objectives. • The student demonstrates insufficient skills and/or ability in accordance to the definitions of the course learning objectives. • The student demonstrates insufficient knowledge and/or understanding in accordance to the definitions of the course learning objectives. <p>Range: Does not fulfill the course learning objectives. A completely new examination is required.</p>
