| A | Excellent | The student demonstrates outstanding in-depth knowledge and understanding of the learning objectives and tasks and can present sociological arguments, demonstrating proficiency in analytical skills. |
| В | Very Good | The student demonstrates in-depth knowledge in all, or nearly all, learning objectives and tasks. He/She shows good understanding of the concepts and can present sociological arguments, demonstrating proficiency in analytical skills. |
| С | Good | The student meets with the learning objectives and demonstrates proficiency in some of the learning objectives and tasks. He/She has a satisfactory command of the concepts and can present sociological arguments, showing ability in analytical skills. |
| D | Satisfactory | The student meets with the learning objectives and tasks and demonstrates proficiency in some of the learning objectives. |
| Е | Sufficient | The student meets with the learning objectives and tasks. |
| Fx | Insufficient Additional Work Required | The student fails to achieve a satisfactory standard in relation to the learning objectives and tasks. Additional work is necessary to fulfill the required learning objectives and tasks. |
| F | Insufficient | The student fails to achieve a satisfactory standard in relation to the learning objectives and tasks. |
