# Application for deferment

You can apply for deferment due to circumstances you may not be able to influence. The circumstances must generally have occurred after you signed up for your education. Deferment from your studies may not exceed 18 months unless there are exceptional reasons for prolongation of the deferment requested.

Special grounds for deferment can be social, medical or other circumstances, e.g. care of children, military service or civil defence service, missions for the student union or postponed leave according to the law about employers right to leave for education (lagen om arbetstagares rätt till ledighet för utbildning).

The reasons you claim must be motivated and proof of this must be enclosed with this application e.g. doctor's report.

## Deferment for military service or civil defence service

You apply for deferment for military service and civil defence service when applying for a programme. Send a copy of your decision of enrolment with the application or as an additional document to Antagningen, 833 82 STRÖMSUND.

### Application for deferment at Mid Sweden University

Mid Sweden University will assess applications for deferment individually. You have to be admitted to a programme to get your deferment application approved. Deferment for courses will not be approved.

If you are granted a deferment a decision notice will be sent to you by mail. Then you have to apply for the programme again and submit a copy of the decision to your application. There will be more information in the decision notice.

If your application of deferment is rejected, you have the right to appeal this decision to the Higher Education Appeals Board (Överklagandenämnden för högskolan). You send this appeal to: **Registrar's Office, Mid Sweden University, 851 70 SUNDSVALL** 

You have to send this appeal so that the Mid Sweden University receives it **three weeks** after the day you got the decision.
