Grade	Definition	Criteria
A	Excellent	The student demonstrates outstanding results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives in civics.
B	Very Good	The student demonstrates excellent results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives in civics.
C	Good	The student demonstrates good results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives in civics.
D	Satisfactory	The student demonstrates satisfactory results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives in civics.
E	Sufficient	The student demonstrates sufficient results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives in civics.
Fx	Insufficient	The student's results are insufficient considering the requirements of the course learning objectives. Additional work is required to fulfill the course learning objectives in civics.
F	Insufficient	The student's results are insufficient considering the requirements of the course learning objectives in civics.
