





# Are these strategies effective?

| Year                    | 2009  |        | 2010  |       | 2013   |        |
|-------------------------|-------|--------|-------|-------|--------|--------|
| Category                | No    | %      | No    | %     | No     | %      |
| Cardiac/ non arrest     | 2     | 0,60%  | 6     | 0,26% | 2      | 0,85%  |
| Other                   | 9     | 2,50%  | 18    | 4,70% | 11     | 4,70%  |
| Asthma                  | 6     | 1,70%  | 10    | 3,80% | 13     | 5,60%  |
| Laceration              | 9     | 2,50%  | 41    | 11%   | 18     | 7,70%  |
| Heat related illness    | 1     | 0,20%  | 11    | 3%    | 2      | 0,85%  |
| Drug/ alcohol treatment | 87    | 24,00% | 99    | 26%   | 81     | 34,70% |
| Minor injuries          | 189   | 52,00% | 152   | 40%   | 50     | 21,40% |
| Minor problems          | 58    | 16,00% | 45    | 12%   | 56     | 24%    |
| Total                   | 361   |        | 382   |       | 233    |        |
| Population              | 6000* | 6%     | 7000* | 5,45% | 10000* | 2,33%  |
