Grade		Criteria
A	Excellent	The student demonstrates outstanding results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.
B	Very Good	The student demonstrates excellent results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.
C	Good	The student demonstrates good results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.
D	Satisfactory	The student demonstrates satisfactory results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.
E	Sufficient	The student demonstrates sufficient results considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.
Fx	Insufficient	The student's results are insufficient considering the requirements of the course learning objectives. Additional work is required to fulfill the course learning objectives.
F	Insufficient	The student's results are insufficient considering the requirements of the course learning objectives.

GRADING CRITERIA: HISTORY

Second Cycle

The grading criteria for the 7-point grading scale implemented by Mid Sweden University, in History Studies. Grading criteria approved by Mid Sweden University and based on subject specific learning objectives and examinations.

Grade	Definition MIUN	Grading Criteria
A	Excellent	The student demonstrates outstanding in-depth ability, presenting original ideas applicable in research context.
B	Very Good	The student demonstrates outstanding in-depth results demonstrating ability to articulate, analyze and discuss relevant topics which can be applied in wider contexts.
C	Good	The student demonstrates good results in terms of having developed an ability to analyze and apply basic knowledge in the subject and critically discuss relevant topics.
D	Satisfactory	The student demonstrates satisfactory results in terms of insight, incorporating an ability to understand and apply basic knowledge in the subject.
E	Sufficient	The student demonstrates acceptable insight to discern and apply the subject in a fundamentally independent way.
Fx	Insufficient Additional Work Required	The student has not developed sufficient acumen to identify and apply the subject in a fundamentally independent way.
F	Insufficient	The student has not developed the acumen to identify and apply the subject in a fundamentally independent way.
