

## **Grading criteria and names for the two- and three-pointed grading scale used at MIUN**

### *General criteria for the criterion-referenced two-pointed grading scale*

#### **Pass (G)**

In order to receive the grade G (Pass), the student must demonstrate sufficient results in relation to the requirements of all the learning objectives.

#### **Fail (U)**

Students who do not demonstrate sufficient results in relation to the requirements of all the learning objectives of the course will receive the grade U (Fail).

### *General criteria for the criterion-referenced three-pointed grading scale*

#### **Pass with distinction (VG)**

In order to receive the grade VG (Pass with distinction), students must demonstrate very good results in relation to the requirements of the learning objectives.

#### **Pass (G)**

In order to receive the grade G (Pass), the student must demonstrate sufficient results in relation to the requirements of all the learning objectives.

#### **Fail (U)**

Students who do not demonstrate sufficient results in relation to the requirements of all the learning objectives of the course will receive the grade U (Fail).
